Promoting sociobiodiversity chains in the Amazon

The murumuru project aims to promote the organization of sustainable agroextractivism of Murumuru (*Astrocaryum murumuru*) in the state of Pará, ensuring an improvement in the quality of life of agroextractivist families and the promotion of sociobiodiversity.

Project beneficiaries

365 families of agroextractivists in the metropolitan mesoregion of Belém, Marajó and the Northeast of Pará, in the municipalities of Santo Antônio do Tauá, Breves and São Miguel do Guamá, respectively.



Infrastructure and equipment






- Acquisition of machines for murumuru seed breaking
- Installation of solar panels for riverside families
- Installation of greenhouses for drying murumuru seeds



The project qualifies for Benefit Sharing, as established by **Law No. 13,123/2015** and its respective Regulatory Decree (No. 8,772/2016), as it develops activities that seek to train human resources, being aimed at agroextractivist families from rural communities in the Amazon.



Expected results

-  Representation of 10 communities from three (03) municipalities in all project actions;
-  365 families of agroextractivists trained in the management, pre-processing and conservation of the Murumuru seed;
-  Inclusion of at least 20 new families in the cooperatives involved in the Project;
-  Adding value to Murumuru products developed by agroextractivists;
-  Strengthening of the Murumuru socio-productive chain in the region, with the inclusion of 100 new families in this process.
